Biden Administration Announces End of the Public Health Emergency

- The Biden Administration announced that the COVID-19 national emergency and public health emergency (PHE) declarations will end May 11, 2023.
- These declarations are currently set to expire on March 1 and April 11, respectively. The Administration's plan is to extend both of the emergency declarations to May 11, and then end both emergencies on that date.
- Releasing this statement in advance of the end of the PHE allows a wind-down period during which the health care system - including health care providers, health plans, and individuals - can prepare for the coming changes.
