CMS Announces Reduced Coinsurance on 27 Part B Prescription Drugs

Under the Medicare Drug Rebate provisions of the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), beneficiary coinsurance will be 20% of the inflation-adjusted payment amount for certain Part B drugs and biologicals with prices that have increased faster than the rate of inflation.

- On March 15, 2023, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) announced a list of 27 prescription drugs for which Part B beneficiary coinsurances may be lower from April 1 – June 30, 2023.
- CMS posts payment information each quarter for separately payable Part B drugs in the Medicare Part B Quarterly Sales Pricing (ASP) file.
- The Part B drugs impacted by a coinsurance adjustment may change quarterly.
