3. **Manage the political action committee—AMCP PAC**
4. **Educate AMCP members on federal and state policy issues**
5. **Operate grassroots and grasstops advocacy programs, including the annual Legislative Days event and Pharmacy Advocacy Leaders Program**

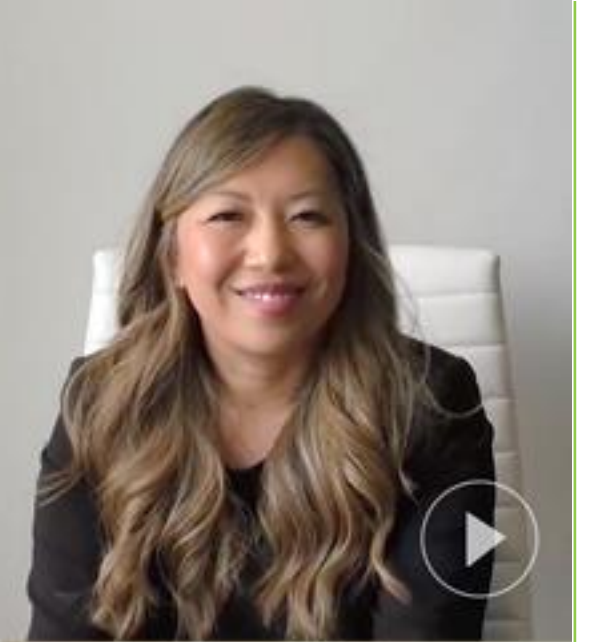
